HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

LAND BILL.

Dr. NEWMAN, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 134, in the third line, to extend the term of non-residence from three to four years.

LAND FOR SETTLEMENTS BILL.

Mr. BUCKLAND, in Committee, to move the insertion of the following new clause:—

Any dealings under this Act shall be exempt from the provisions of "The Disqualification Act, 1878," or any Act amending the same.

ELECTORAL BILL.

Mr. McLEAN, in Committee, to move,—

After the words "commercial traveller," in clause 63, line 3, the following words shall be added: "or any other elector who may be absent from his electoral district from any cause whatever."

Mr. FISH, in Committee, to move,—

That in clause 3, line 9, the words "or her," in the third line, be struck out.

In clause 6, subsection 1, to strike out the words "or her," in the second line.

PROPERTY LAW CONSOLIDATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BUCKLAND, in Committee, to move a new clause,—

*New Clause.*

Section forty-seven of "The Property Law Consolidation Act, 1883," is hereby amended by the addition of the following words to the end of the third subsection: "Including the furnishing in New Zealand of true and attested copies of all deeds, documents, or writings which may be required for evidencing the title of the estate or interest thereby-conveyed."
