POLICE OFFENCES AMENDMENT BILL.

Sir W. R. RUSSELL, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

8. Section fifteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the words "or make it illegal to spray with arsenic or other poisonous liquid any noxious weeds at any time between the thirtieth day of April and the thirty-first day of December in any year":

Provided that on the day such poisonous liquid is used and for thirty days thereafter the word "Poison," painted in white-lead paint in letters not less than four inches in length on a black board, shall be fixed on a pole not less than eight feet above the ground in some conspicuous position near to the place where the poisonous liquid is used.
