### POLICE OFFENCES BILL.

Hon. Mr. HERDMAN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Inciting to the  
commission of  
offences.

4. Any person who incites any other person to commit any offence punishable by imprisonment, whether on summary conviction or on indictment, shall be guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction by a fine not exceeding *twenty* pounds or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding *three* months nor exceeding the maximum term of imprisonment to which a person who commits the first-mentioned offence is liable.
