POLICE OFFENCES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. Cobbe, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2, subclause (2): To add to this subclause the following words: "No proceedings for an offence against this section shall be commenced save on an information laid by a constable or other officer of Police".

To insert, after subclause (2), the following new subclause:—

(2A) Where in respect of an offence against this section an information is laid in the Form No. 4 in the First Schedule to the Justices of the Peace Act, 1927 See Reprint (as for a matter determinable summarily), the matter of Statutes, vol. II, p. 469 shall be dealt with summarily and not otherwise. Where in respect of an offence against this section an information is laid in the Form No. 31 in the First Schedule to the Ibid., p. 481 Justices of the Peace Act, 1927, the matter shall be dealt with on indictment unless it is dealt with summarily in accordance with the provisions of the next succeeding subsection.
