POWERS OF SEARCH (INTERNAL CONCEALMENT) BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Bills

Hon. GEOFFREY PALMER, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 2 and 3 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966 to clarify the power to detain persons suspected of secreting controlled drugs or other goods about their persons for unlawful purposes

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1985.

That clauses 5 to 7, and the Schedule, be a separate Bill, and that for clause 5 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 to define the circumstances in which persons may be detained on belief of concealing Class A controlled drugs or Class B controlled drugs within their bodies for unlawful purposes, to define the rights of persons while so detained, and to define the powers and duties of the Police and Customs Officers in respect of such detained persons

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1985.
