PUBLIC REVENUES ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. JOYCE to move, in Committee:—

The repeal of section twenty-six of "The Public Revenues Act, 1878."

That section six of "The Disqualification Act, 1878," shall be inoperative in those cases where a member of the Legislative Council or House of Representatives shall be appointed Controller and Auditor-General, Assistant-Controller and Auditor-General, or Deputy-Controller and Auditor-General.

HOSPITALS AND CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. FELDWICK, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

If the Trustees of any separate institution shall deem the amount of any grant made, or proposed to be made, to them by the District Board to be insufficient, they may appeal from the decision of the Board by transmitting a copy of any resolution expressing their dissent to the Colonial Secretary, who thereupon shall direct an inquiry to be made in the same manner as provided in section forty-four of "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885," in relation to inquiring into objections against incorporation. The said section shall apply *mutatis mutandis*, and the decision of the Commissioners shall be final.
