PUBLIC REVENUES AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Power to
transfer from
separate
account to
General
Account.

A. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in section one hundred and thirty-four of the Counties Act, 1908, it shall be lawful for a local authority, with the consent of the Audit Office, to transfer to its General Account any sum from any separate account which it is by law required to keep.

(2.) The sum so transferred, or such part thereof as the Audit Office requires, shall be repaid from the General Account to the separate account from which it was transferred within three months after receipt by the local authority of a notice in that behalf from the Audit Office.
