Proposed amendments

Dianne Yates, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 5

To omit this clause.

New heading and clause 9CA

To insert, after clause 9C (after line 21 on page 13), the following heading and clause:

Prohibition on person being client to prostitution

9CA Being client in act of prostitution

Every person who is a client in an act of prostitution by any person commits an offence and is liable on conviction to—

- (a) imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months; or
- (b) a fine not exceeding \$5,000.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the bill to provide that it is unlawful to be a client in an act of prostitution.
