PUBLIC SERVICE CLASSIFICATION AND SUPERANNUATION AMENDMENT BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Governor in
Council may
exempt any
office from
Part II of
principal Act.

58A. (1.) The Governor may from time to time by Order in Council declare that any place or office in the public service shall not be or shall cease to be subject to Part II of the principal Act.

(2.) On the making of any such Order in Council any place or office so specified shall be deemed to be not included in the public service within the meaning and for the purposes of Part II of the principal Act:

Provided that no such Order in Council shall apply to or affect any person who at the time of the making thereof holds any such place or office, and who is already a contributor to the Public Service Superannuation Fund in respect of that place or office, and every such person shall continue to be a contributor to the fund in the same manner in all respects as if no such Order in Council were in force.

Repeal.

(3.) Section fifty-two of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (g) thereof, but this repeal shall not affect any Order in Council heretofore made under the authority of the said section.
