NOR AND MAIN TRUNK RAILWAY LOAN APPLICATION ACT 1886 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WILSON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

. It shall be lawful, out of the moneys to the credit of the North Island Trunk Loan, to expend from time to time such moneys as may be appropriated by the General Assembly, and may be necessary, for the purpose of making roads or river-works on or adjacent to the railway or proposed central line of railway, or leading from the said line.

TIMARU HIGH SCHOOL ACT 1878 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. RHODES, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

. Section four of "The Timaru High School Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1882," is hereby repealed, and, in lieu thereof, it is hereby enacted that the Timaru High School Board (hereinafter called "the said Board") shall consist of ten persons, one of whom shall be appointed by the County Council of the County of Waimate, two by the County Council of the County of Geraldine, one by the County Council of the County of Mackenzie, one by the Governor, and the remaining four persons shall be elected by the burgesses of the Borough of Timaru, in manner hereinafter appointed.

PUBLIC WORKS ACTS AMENDMENT.

Mr. TAIPUA, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 18, to add, "and every sitting of the said Court to be held for the purpose of dealing with such land shall be duly notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* and *Kahiti Maori*."

Also, "Nothing contained in this or any former Acts shall be deemed to authorise the taking for public purposes of any burial-place, pa, cultivation, settlement, ornamental ground, or karaka grove without the consent of the Native owner or owners."
