PUBLIC WORKS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. HALL-JONES, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 4: To strike out the word "thereof," at end of clause, and add the following words after the word "three."

(3.) And in lieu of such subsection it is hereby enacted that the owner of the land so dedicated shall be entitled to compensation by the local authority having control of the road or street; and in assessing such compensation the Compensation Court constituted for that purpose shall take into consideration the circumstances of the whole subdivision, the necessity for or advantage of affording greater street-space, the betterment accruing to the whole property and the amount of benefit derived from subdividing the property, compared with dealing with it as a whole, and any such betterment, benefit, or profit shall be a set-off against the compensation claimed.
