PUBLIC WORKS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

A. On the petition of not less than two-thirds of the owners having frontage on any undedicated and unformed road of not less than sixty-six feet in width, which had for five years or upwards prior to the year one thousand nine hundred been used as a public road, the local authority may form the same and apportion the cost thereof amongst the whole of the said owners in proportion to the frontage held by them respectively, and may recover the amount so apportioned as if the same were a rate.
