QUEEN'S SCHOLARSHIPS BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

In clause 2, line 14, before "six junior scholarships," insert "in and after the year one thousand nine hundred and three"; and omit the words commencing in line 22, "and the Council may, with the approval of the Minister of Education, restrict the number of scholarships to be awarded," and substitute the words "nor more than four scholarships."

In clause 2 (*b*), line 3, before "not less than four," insert "in and after the year one thousand nine hundred and six."

To clause 2 add the following subclause:—

- (*i*.) If the holder of any scholarship forfeits or resigns his scholarship, or dies during the currency of the scholarship, then at the next examinations the Council shall offer such additional scholarships (if necessary) as will make the total number of scholarships current during the ensuing year not less than thirty.

In clause 4, omit all words after "day of March," and substitute "the sum of two hundred pounds in addition to the sum of four thousand pounds payable to the Council under the principal Act."

To clause 5 add the following proviso:—

Provided that nothing in this Act shall affect any scholarship granted under the principal Act except as provided in section *three* hereof.
