RATING ACT AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Hon. Mr. TOLE, to move the following:—

5D. Every person to be affected by any alteration in a valuation-roll made by any local body under any powers authorizing it in that behalf shall be entitled to object, and to have the objection heard before any Resident Magistrate who, for the purposes of this section, shall have all the powers and authorities of a Board of Reviewers and the Chairman thereof, under "The Property Assessment Act, 1879."

All notices and other proceedings provided with respect to original assessments under the Act last mentioned, and the objections against the same and the hearing thereof before a Board of Reviewers, shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply with respect to the alterations in a valuation-roll, objections and the hearing thereof before a Resident Magistrate under the provisions of this section.
