REPRESENTATION ACT AMENDMENT.

Sir G. GREY, when the Bill intituled "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1889," is under consideration in Committee, to move the following amendments therein:—

That no elector shall, after the passing of this Act, vote in respect of more than one electorate at any election of members of the House of Representatives.

That "The Representation Acts Amendment Act, 1887," is hereby repealed, and the provisions of "The Representation Act, 1887," which were repealed by "The Representation Acts Amendment Act, 1887," are hereby re-enacted.

That a dissolution of the General Assembly shall take place on or before the day of August next.
