RATING AMENDMENT BILL.

Amendments proposed by His Excellency the Governor:—

The Title of the Bill to be altered to "An Act to amend the Rating Act, 1908."

Clause 23: To add the following subsection:—

(2A.) The *preceding* subsections of this section shall come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and *twelve*.

To omit clause 24, and substitute the following:

24. (1.) The Governor may from time to time, on the application of any local authority, appoint two persons to be members of the Assessment Court, in addition to the Judge thereof mentioned in section twenty-three of the principal Act.

(2.) One of such persons shall be appointed on the recommenda-

tion of the local authority.

(3.) A member of the local authority shall not be appointed to

act as a member of the Assessment Court.

(4.) The two members so appointed as aforesaid shall be paid by the local authority such reasonable fees and allowances as may be

fixed by the local authority.

(5.) The production of a copy of any public notice or advertisement stating the names of the members of whom the Court will be constituted shall be *prima facie* proof that the members of the Court so constituted are duly appointed and qualified.
