RACING AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendment

Hon. PETER TAPSELL, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 6: To omit new paragraph (aa) of section 37 (15) in lines 21 to 24 on page 4, and substitute the following paragraphs:

- “(aa) That the totalisator shall not be open for the purpose of receiving bets earlier than 2 hours before the appointed time for the start of the first race;
- “(ab) That, where intertrack betting applies, the totalisator of a selling club shall not be open for the purpose of transmitting bets to any destination club later than 1 hour after the start of the last race on each day of a race meeting of the selling club;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

At present the Bill provides that the totalisator at a meeting is not to be open after the start of the last race. This amendment enables the totalisator to remain open for one hour after the start of the last race of the selling club in the case of intertrack betting.
