

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Friday, the 10th day of November, 1871.

1. Mr. J. C. BROWN, on going into Committee of Supply, to move, That a respectful Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor, requesting that he may be pleased to place on the Supplementary Estimates a sufficient sum of money to make the necessary alterations in the Court House at Lawrence for the holding of Sessions of the Supreme Court at that place.
2. Mr. SWANSON to move, The insertion of the following words in the First Schedule of the Railways Bill :—" Extension of the Onehunga Branch of the Auckland and Drury Line to Mangarei."
3. Mr. REID to move, in Committee on the Railways Bill, to insert in the First Schedule, "Construction of line from Mosgiel to Outram: Provided it can be constructed at a cost not exceeding £5,000 per mile."
