SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Thursday, the 14th day of October, 1875.

1. Mr. J. Shephard to move, when in Committee on the Representation Bill:-

GREY VALLEY DISTRICT—Two MEMBERS.

This district is bounded towards the North by a right line due east from Razorback Point to the summit of the Paparoa Mountains; thence towards the North-west by right lines from peak to peak along the summit of the said mountains to the Buckland Peaks; thence again towards the North by a right line to the junction of the Colin or Awarua River with the Inangahua River, thence by a right line due east to the summit of the Brunner Mountains; towards the East by right lines from peak to peak along the summit of the Brunner and Victoria Mountains to Mount Haast; thence towards the North-east by a right line through Lake Christabel to the boundary of the Cheviot District; towards the South-east by the Cheviot District to the saddle between the Hurunui and Teremakau Rivers; towards the South by the north bank of the Teremakau River to the sea; and again towards the North-west by the sea to Razorback Point.

2. Mr. Ballance to move, when in Committee on the Representation Bill, That the following proviso be added to clause 6:—

Provided that at a contested election for any electoral district represented by three members, no person shall vote for more than two candidates.

3. Mr. Dignan to move, when in Committee on the Representation Bill, as an amendment to clause 6, that the following words be omitted, viz.,—

The Electoral Districts of Auckland City East and Auckland City West, as now constituted under the said Acts, shall together form one district, and be called by the name of "Auckland City District."

4. Mr. Gibbs to move, on the Question for going into Committee of Supply, That the time for claiming the Bonus for the manufacture of Iron and Steel be extended to 30th June, 1877.
