REFERENDUM BILL.

Mr. ELL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

In clause 4: To insert the following new subclause, to follow subclause (b):—

(b1.) If twenty-five thousand electors request by petition to Parliament that any Bill or legislative proposal named in such petition be submitted to the referendum; or.

In clause 15, line 35: To strike out the words "ten per centum," and to insert in lieu thereof the words "twenty-five thousand."
