Mr. SMITH to move, on the second reading of the Customs Duties Bill, That it be read this day six months.

RIVER BOARDS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. MACARTHUR, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

Where any stream or river extends beyond the limits of a river district and its obstruction is likely to cause damage to property within such district, the Board may order the occupier, or when there is no occupier, the owner of any land on the banks of such stream or river for the space of one mile beyond the upstream boundary of such district to remove any driftwood, tree, shrub, or bush, or any part thereof impeding the free flow of water in the said stream or river, or to lower or trim any part of a tree, shrub, or bush overhanging such stream or river and likely to fall therein within the space of the aforesaid mile ; and in case of the owner or occupier failing to comply with such order within fourteen days from the receipt thereof he shall be liable to the penalties provided in clause four of "The River Boards Act 1884 Amendment Act, 1885."
