REPORT OF THE SECOND CONFERENCE UPON THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS AMENDMENT
BILL.

THE Managers appointed to conduct the Conference upon the Municipal Corporations Amendment Bill on behalf of the House of Representatives have the honour to report that they have met the Managers appointed to conduct the same on behalf of the Legislative Council, and that they have come to the following agreement, namely:—

Clause 11, subclause (1.): To strike out the words "one-fourth" inserted by the Council in line 4 of paragraph (a), and to substitute therefor the words "one-fifth."

Clause 22: In line 9 of new subclause (1A) inserted by the Council, after the word "tramway," to insert the following words:—

"The establishment and maintenance of a motor service for the purpose only of serving areas not served by, or not adequately served by, the tramway shall not be deemed to be in contravention of the provisions of this subsection, notwithstanding that part of the course of such service is through streets in which the said tramway is laid and which are served by the tramway."
