ROADS VALIDATION BILL.

Hon. Mr. McKENZIE to move the following amendments :—

Clause 2, paragraph 2, line 17 : After “highway,” insert “for such width as may have been previously agreed upon, or enclosed within fences not less than fifty links apart, or if not so agreed upon.”

After clause 3 to insert the following new clause :—

4. In the case of new roads taken or constructed through private lands under agreement with the owner thereof that the local authority shall fence the same, any County Council or Road Board may in its corporate capacity agree with the owner or lessee of such lands to permit a gate to be erected across such road until such time as such Council or Board shall construct or cause to be constructed a substantial fence on each side of such road for its whole distance through such lands. The said Council or Board shall have power to make by-laws providing penalties for leaving any such gate open or for damaging the same.
