ON GOING INTO COMMITTEE OF SUPPLY.

Mr. Fish to move,—

That the financial proposals of the Government are in accordance with the general wishes of the people, providing as they do for the repeal of the property-tax, and substituting in lieu thereof a graduated land-tax and income-tax.

That the principle of the change in the incidence of taxation therein indicated is satisfactory to this House, and will promote the well-being of all classes in the colony.

Mr. O'CONOR to move, by way of amendment in addition to Mr. Fish's Motion on going into Committee of Supply,—

But that this House strongly urges upon the Government to withhold for the present the reduction upon postages, &c., and retain the additional revenue as a means of elaborating their schemes to facilitate land settlement.
