SHEARERS' ACCOMMODATION BILL.

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 6, line 16: After the word "where," insert the words "no accommodation is provided, or where."

Same clause, line 18: After the word "to," insert the word "provide."

Clause 7, line 29: After the word "Magistrate," insert the words "shall find that no accommodation is provided by the defendant employer, or."

Same clause, line 31: After the word "what," insert the words "accommodation or what."

Same clause, line 31: After the word "accommodation," insert the words "as the case may be."

Clause 9, line 51: Strike out "and," and insert "but."

Clause 12, line 12: Strike out "or," and insert "nor."

EDUCATION BOARDS ELECTION BILL.

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 7, line 5: Strike out the word "published." Also, same line: Strike out "circulating," and insert "published."

Clause 7, line 9: After the word "he," insert "or she."

Clause 11, line 35: Strike out the word "him," and insert the words "the Returning Officer."
