STATUTES AMENDMENT BILL

Hon. Mr. MASON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 34: To omit this clause.

To insert the following new clause:—

34A. For the purposes of the principal Act, every person who is wholly or mainly engaged in procuring proposals or contracts of industrial life assurance or in collecting industrial life assurance premiums for any person, firm, company, society, association, or corporation carrying on industrial life assurance business and is remunerated wholly or partly by fees or commission shall be deemed to be a worker employed by that person, firm, company, society, association, or corporation, whether or not the relation between them is that of master and servant.
