STATUTES AMENDMENT BILL

*Proposed Amendment*

HON. D. A. M. GRAHAM, in Committee, to move as follows:

PART 14

FAIR TRADING ACT 1986

To omit clause 102 (lines 7 to 16 on page 24) and substitute the following clause:

**102. Transitional provisions relating to regulations in force before commencement of this Part—**(1) Regulations made under section 27 or section 28 of the principal Act (as in force before the commencement of this Part of this Act) and that were in force immediately before the commencement of this Part of this Act are deemed to have been made under **section 27** of the principal Act (as substituted by this Part of this Act).

(2) Regulations made under section 29 or section 30 or under both sections 29 and 30 of the principal Act (as in force before the commencement of this Part of this Act) and that were in force immediately before the commencement of this Part of this Act are deemed to have been made under **section 29** of the principal Act (as substituted by this Part of this Act).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposed new *clause 102* corrects references to the sections in the Fair Trading Act 1986 under which regulations have been made prescribing consumer information standards and product safety standards. The clause continues those regulations in force and treats them as having been made under the new *sections 27* and *29* as enacted by the Bill.
