STATUTES AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 4)

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon D A M GRAHAM, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part 33 and Schedules 5 and 6* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 185* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 1998, and is part of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 (“the principal Act”).

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

(3) Sections 193 and 194 come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

That *Part 34 and Schedules 7 and 8* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 198* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Amendment Act 1998, and is part of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Statutes Amendment Bill (No. 4) so that Parts 33 and 34 become 2 different Bills, namely:
