Proposed motion to divide Bill into 32 Bills

Hon Paul Swain, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, and Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 to 3*, and the Part heading before *clause 3* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Animal Welfare Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Animal Welfare Act 1999 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 8* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Antarctic Marine Living Resources Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Antarctic Marine Living Resources Act 1981 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 11* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Apple and Pear Industry Restructuring Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Apple and Pear Industry Restructuring Act 1999 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 13* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Armed Forces Discipline Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4A and Schedule 1A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 18A* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Births, Deaths, and Marriages Registration Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Births, Deaths, and Marriages Registration Act 1995 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 19* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Broadcasting Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Broadcasting Act 1989 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5A and Schedule 1B* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 20A* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Citizenship Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Citizenship Act 1987 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 6* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 21* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Conservation Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Conservation Act 1987 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 7* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 23* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 2001.

- (2) In this Act, the Criminal Justice Act 1985 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 8 and Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for *clauses 25 and 26* and the Part heading before them there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Customs and Excise Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Customs and Excise Act 1996 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 31** comes into force on 1 December 2001.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 9* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 37* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Defence Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Defence Act 1990 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 10* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 42* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Dietitians Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Dietitians Act 1950 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 11* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 46* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Electricity Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Electricity Act 1992 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 12* be a separate Bill, and that for *clauses 49 and 50* and the Part heading before them there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Fisheries Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Fisheries Act 1996 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 October 2001.

That *Part 13* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 63* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Foundation for Research, Science, and Technology Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Foundation for Research, Science, and Technology Act 1990 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 14* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 66* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Gas Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Gas Act 1992 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 15* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 70* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Goods and Services Tax Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 15A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clauses 71A and 71B* and the Part heading before them there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Juries Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Juries Act 1981 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2002.

That *Part 15B* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 71F* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Legal Services Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Legal Services Act 2000 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 16* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 72* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Maori Fisheries Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Maori Fisheries Act 1989 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 17 and Schedule 2* be a separate Bill, and that for that for *clause 74* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1992 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 18* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 78* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the National Parks Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the National Parks Act 1980 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 19* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 80* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the New Zealand Council for Educational Research Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the New Zealand Council for Educational Research Act 1972 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 20* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 86* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Oaths and Declarations Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 20A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 88A* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Police Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Police Act 1958 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 21* be a separate Bill, and that for *clauses 89 and 90* and the Part heading before them there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Pork Industry Board Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Pork Industry Board Act 1997 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Sections 91 and 92** come into force on 31 July 2002.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 22* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 94* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Postal Services Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Postal Services Act 1988 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 23* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 96* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Privacy Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Privacy Act 1993 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 24* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 100* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Royal New Zealand Foundation for the Blind Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Royal New Zealand Foundation for the Blind Act 1963 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 24A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 106A* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 25 and Schedule 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 107* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Telecommunications Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Telecommunications Act 1987 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 26* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 112* and the Part heading before it there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Weights and Measures Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Weights and Measures Act 1987 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
