SLAUGHTERING AND INSPECTION BILL.

Mr. Fowlds, on recommittal, to move the following new clause to follow clause:

(1.) In any case where the majority of the butchers carrying on business in any district agree to raise a fund by their own contributions to provide compensation in respect of the condemnation of the carcases of diseased stock, they may submit such agreement

to the Governor for approval.

(2.) If the Governor approves of the terms of the agreement, and is satisfied that the subscribers thereto are a majority of the butchers carrying on business in the district, he may, by Order in Council, declare that the agreement shall be binding on all the butchers carrying on business in that district, and such order shall operate accordingly.

(3.) Any contribution payable in respect of such agreement may

be recovered summarily from any butcher liable to pay the same.

(4.) This section shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to any combined district in which a common abattoir is established under sections fifteen and fifteen a hereof respectively.

(5.) The Governor may from time to time make regulations for

carrying the provisions of this section into effect.
