SHOPS AND OFFICES BILL.

Mr. BARCLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

Clause 2. Insert “ ‘ Domestic servant ’ means any female engaged for hire to perform work of a manual character in a private house.”

If the amendments proposed by Supplementary Order Paper No. 50 in clause 31, subsection (5), are carried, to insert in that clause, after “ restaurants,” “ or as domestic servants.” In paragraphs (a) and (b), omit “ or ”; after “ restaurant,” insert “ or private house where a domestic servant is employed.” In paragraph (c), after “ restaurant,” insert “ and every domestic servant.”

If the amendments proposed by Supplementary Order Paper No. 50 in clause 31, subsection (5), are not carried, then to insert in that clause, after “ hotel or not,” “ or as domestic servants.” In paragraphs (a) and (b), omit “ or ”; after “ restaurant,” insert “ or private house where a domestic servant is employed.” In paragraph (c), after “ restaurant,” insert “ and every domestic servant.” In paragraph (d), insert “ and all domestic servants ” between the words “ hotel bars ” and “ shall.”
