SHOPS AND OFFICES BILL.

Mr. Barclay, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2. Insert "'Domestic servant' means any female engaged for hire

to perform work of a manual character in a private house."

If the amendments proposed by Supplementary Order Paper No. 50 in clause 31, subsection (5), are carried, to insert in that clause, after "restaurants," "or as domestic servants." In paragraphs (a) and (b), omit "or"; after "restaurant," insert "or private house where a domestic servant is employed." In paragraph (c), after "restaurant," insert "and every domestic servant."

If the amendments proposed by Supplementary Order Paper No. 50 in clause 31, subsection (5), are not carried, then to insert in that clause, after "hotel or not," "or as domestic servants." In paragraphs (a) and (b), omit "or"; after "restaurant," insert "or private house where a domestic servant is employed." In paragraph (c), after "restaurant," insert "and every domestic servant." In paragraph (d), insert "and all domestic servants" between the words "hotel bars" and "shall."
