## SHIPPING AND SEAMEN AMENDMENT BILL

*Further Proposed Amendments*

Hon. Mr GORDON, in Committee, to move the following further amendments:

*Clause 2, subclause (1)*: To insert in the definition of the expression "daylight excursion", after the word "completed" in line 3 on page 2, the words "or is scheduled to be completed".

*Clause 2, subclause (7)*: To insert, before paragraph (a), the following paragraph:

(aa) Subsection (6) of section 241 of the principal Act:

*Clause 5*: To omit from the proposed section 151k the words "secretarial, recording, clerical" in line 37, and substitute the word "administrative".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*Clause 2, subclause (1)*: This amendment is intended to meet the position where a voyage or excursion is scheduled to be completed not later than 1 hour after sunset but due to unforeseen circumstances, such as weather, the voyage or excursion is not completed by the scheduled time.

*Clause 2, subclause (7)*: This is a further consequential repeal.

*Clause 5*: This amendment is intended to enable the Shipping Industry Tribunal to make full use of all services provided by the Ministry of Transport.
