AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN THE SHIPPING AND SEAMEN BILL.

Pursuant to section 56 of the Constitution Act, the Governor returns to the House of Representatives the Bill intituled "An Act to consolidate and amend the Acts relating to Shipping and Seamen," with the following amendment, that is to say,—

To add to clause 2 the following subclause:—

(2.) The provisions of this Act shall be so construed as not to exceed the legislative powers conferred on the General Assembly by the Imperial Merchant Shipping Act.
