SECURITIES ADVERTISING BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr THOMSON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6Q (2): To omit this subclause (all the words in lines 9 to 11 on page 27).

Clause 6R (2): To omit the words "Every such appeal shall be heard and determined by the Administrative Division of the Supreme Court." in lines 26 to 28 on page 27.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of this amendment is to remove the requirement that questions of law and appeals against decisions of the Securities Commission be determined by the Administrative Division of the Supreme Court. Such questions and appeals will instead be determined by the Supreme Court.
