SHIPPING BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. RICHARD PREBBLE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6: To insert in paragraph (b) of subclause (3), after the word "information" (line 25, page 11), the words "(being information that may be withheld under the Official Information Act 1982)".

To insert in subclause (5), after the word "information" (line 31, page 11), the words "(being information that may be withheld under the Official Information Act 1982)".

Clause 7: To insert, after line 35 on page 12, the following words:
“(2) Any direction issued under this section may—”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 6 deals with reports on investigations into unfair shipping practices. The proposed amendments ensure that confidential or sensitive commercial information contained in any such report will not be withheld unless it can also be withheld under the Official Information Act 1982.

The amendment to *clause 7* corrects a printing hiccup.
