SECRET COMMISSIONS BILL.

7A. Every person is guilty of an offence who advises any person to enter into a contract with a third person and receives or agrees to receive from that third person, without the knowledge and consent of the person so advised, any gift or consideration as an inducement or reward for the giving of that advice, unless the person giving that advice was to the knowledge of the person so advised the agent of that third person.
