SEA CARRIAGE OF GOODS BILL.

Mr. McCallum, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 7: To add the following after subclause (1):—

(la.) Any person, firm, or company acting in New Zealand as agent for the owner or master of any ship who has issued a through bill of lading for delivery of goods at a New Zealand port shall be liable to pay the consignee of such goods damages for short delivery, injury, or pillage of the same, and such damages shall be recoverable in any Court in New Zealand having jurisdiction to the amount of the damages claimed.

Clause 8: To omit the word "master" at the end of clause, and insert the word "owner" in lieu thereof.
