STAMP DUTIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. McCALLUM, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

Graduated
scale of duty.

A. (1.) Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act, the duty chargeable in respect of conveyance on sale shall, from and after the first day of April, nineteen hundred and *fourteen*, be graduated so that duty on sums exceeding five thousand pounds shall be increased by way of graduation above the present amounts, and those under the sum of five thousand pounds decreased in a gradual scale down to two shillings and sixpence per fifty pounds; but so that the total amount of duty collected shall not be more than would have been collected had the duties remained on the present uniform scale.

(2.) The Governor in Council is hereby authorized and empowered to make and gazette from time to time regulations for the purpose of carrying out the graduation of the said duties.
