STAMP DUTIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. DOWNIE STEWART, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

Exemption from
duty of
agreements to
supply and
receive
electricity.

5A. Section one hundred and fifty-four of the principal Act, as amended by section thirteen of the Stamp Duties Amendment Act, 1924, is hereby further amended as from the passing of the last-mentioned Act by adding to subsection five thereof the following paragraph :—

“(g) Any agreement made between an Electric-power Board or other authority or person licensed to supply electricity and a purchaser or prospective purchaser of electricity, in so far as such agreement relates to the sale and purchase of electricity or to the sale and purchase of electric fittings, equipment, or appliances, or the installation thereof.”
