## **Smoke-free Environments Amendment Bill**

## Proposed amendments

Peter Brown, in committee, to move the following amendments:

### Clause 1A

To omit this clause, and substitute the following clause:

#### 1A Commencement

- (1) Except as provided in **subsection (2)**, this Act comes into force on the day after—
  - (a) the Chief Electoral Officer has declared the final result of a national referendum to be held at the next general election which asks the question, "Should the Smokefree Environments Amendment Act 2003 become law?"; and
  - (b) a majority of those voting in the referendum answers "Yes" to the question.
- (2) **Subsection (1)** comes into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

#### Clause 6B

To add to proposed section 10 (after line 29 on page 16), as subsection (2), the following subsection:

"(2) Nothing in this Act may compromise the safety of a ship or seaborne vessel in terms of fire or other similar hazard. In such circumstances the rules for smoking and non-smoking on a ship or seaborne vessel must be determined by the Master.
