### SALE OF LIQUOR BILL

#### *Proposed Amendments*

MR MACINTYRE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 162, subclause (1):* To omit this subclause, and substitute the following subclauses:

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Part of this Act, every charter granted under this Part, and every charter granted under the provisions of any previous enactment and in force at the commencement of this Act, shall authorise the club to sell and dispose of any liquor to any member of the club, for consumption on or off the premises of the club.

(1A) Every such charter as aforesaid, and every renewal of any such charter, shall be deemed to be granted subject to the condition that sales of liquor for consumption off the premises shall be in accordance with such requirements relating to the control of such sales (whether as to the total quantity of liquor that may be sold to any one member in any one year or otherwise) as the Commission may from time to time impose.

*Clause 162, subclause (3):* To omit the words "such charter", in line 30, and substitute the words "charter granted under this Part".

*Clause 162, subclause (4):* To omit this subclause, and substitute the following subclause:

(4) On the grant or renewal of a charter under this Part, a fee of forty pounds shall be paid to the Commission. Out of every fee so paid the sum of thirty pounds shall be paid to the Licensing Fund.

*Clause 163, subclause (5):* To omit the words "section 164", in line 23, and substitute the words "sections 162 and 164".

*Clause 173, subclause (1):* To omit the words "ten pounds", in line 1 on page 106, and substitute the words "forty pounds".

*Clause 173:* To insert, after subclause (1), the following subclause:

(1A) Out of every fee paid to the Commission under this section the sum of thirty pounds shall be paid to the Licensing Fund.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of these amendments is, firstly, that every club charter now in force or hereafter granted will authorise the sale of liquor to members for consumption off the premises, subject to such requirements as to the control of such sales as the Commission may impose.

Secondly, the annual fee for every club charter will be £40 instead of £10. Out of that fee £30 will be paid to the Licensing Fund.
