SALE OF LIQUOR BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

Mr GORDON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 249:* To insert, after subclause (7), the following subclause:

(7A) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (b) of subsection (7) of this section, the Licensing Committee may from time to time, in writing, authorise the use, for the purposes of that paragraph, of any specified bar of any particular licensed premises, if it is satisfied that no suitable room that is not used by lodgers is available on the premises for those purposes; and may at any time, in writing, revoke any such authorisation. While any such authorisation remains in force, it shall have effect according to its tenor, and the provisions of the said paragraph (b), and any other provision of this Act by which that paragraph is applied, shall be deemed to be extended accordingly in respect of those premises.
