SALE OF LIQUOR BILL

Proposed Amendment

Mr BRAYBROOKE in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 123: To insert on page 96, after subclause (3), the following subclause:

(3A) If the licensee, manager, or other person suspects that any person seeking to be sold or supplied with liquor may be under the age of 20 years, he or she may require that person to state in writing the date of his or her birth; and, if that person refuses to do so, the licensee, manager, or other person may refuse to sell or supply liquor to him or her.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This amendment makes it clear that a licensee, manager, or member of staff may ask for a written statement of age by a customer who appears to be under age. If that person refuses to make such a statement, he or she may be refused liquor. If he or she gives a false statement, he or she commits an offence against clause 136.
