SALE OF LIQUOR BILL  
*Proposed Amendments*

Mr ROGER McLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 173c:* To insert in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) on page 135 (as substituted by Supplementary Order Paper No. 123), after the words "licensing trust", the words "or a club".

To omit subparagraph (iA) of that paragraph (as so substituted).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

It is intended to seek recommitment of *clause 173c* to enable these amendments to be considered.

The amendments preserve the right (originally conferred in the Bill) of chartered clubs in licensing districts to apply for off-licences. That right was taken away by the amendments set out in Supplementary Order Paper No. 123 in the name of the Member for Waitaki.
