COMMITTEE OF SUPPLY.

Mr. HUTCHISON, on going into Committee of Supply, to move:—

That, in the opinion of this House, the reduction of 10 per cent. should not apply to salaries and wages of £150 per annum and under.

SPECIAL POWERS AND CONTRACTS BILL.

Hon. Mr. ROLLESTON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

FIRST COLUMN.

23. By a deed of mortgage dated the 5th May, 1873, registered at Wellington, No. 16346, Robert Douglas Wallace mortgaged certain lands to John Howard Wallace and Edward Swartz Maunsell to secure certain moneys and interest. This mortgage was, by deed dated the 24th April, 1879, assigned to Manihera te Rangitakaiwaho, who again by deed, dated the 26th November, 1879, assigned it to Her Majesty the Queen. It is necessary to give the Governor power to release or assign this mortgage.

SECOND COLUMN.

23. To authorize the Governor to execute a release or assignment of a certain deed of mortgage dated the 5th May, 1873, registered at Wellington, No. 16346, and made between Robert Douglas Wallace therein described of the one part, and John Howard Wallace and Edward Swartz Maunsell therein described of the other part, and to reconvey or convey by assignment the lands described in the said deed, and either to discharge the said lands from all principal moneys and interest secured by the said deed, or to assign such principal moneys and interest, and the benefit of all powers, covenants, and provisos in the said deed expressed or implied.

Mr. TOLE, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

FIRST COLUMN.

AUCKLAND—

To give effect to the recommendation of the Native Lands Committee of the House of Representatives.

The scrip to be exercised in the purchase of Crown lands in the Provincial District of Auckland, and to be exercised within six months from the day this Act comes into operation.

To allow Thomas Cleary to select 80 acres of land out of any rural lands open for sale by the Land Board of Auckland, and to issue a Crown grant for such land so selected; such selection to be made within six months from the day this Act comes into operation.
