STATUTORY PUBLICATIONS BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Separate Bills

Hon. W. P. JEFFRIES, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 53 to 87 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 53 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act—

- (a) To provide for the printing and publication of copies of Acts of Parliament and statutory regulations; and
- (b) To ensure that copies of Acts of Parliament and statutory regulations are available to the public; and
- (c) To provide for the Government Printing Office to cease to be a department of the Public Service

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989.

(2) Except as provided in sections 70 (4), 74 (2), 77 (2), 82 (2), 83 (2), and 84 (2) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That clauses 88 to 98 and the Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 88 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act—

- (a) To provide for the disallowance of statutory regulations; and
- (b) To repeal the Regulations Act 1936 and other enactments

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989.
