## SOCIAL SECURITY AMENDMENT BILL

*Proposed Amendment*

Hon. Mr KING, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*New clause 22A:* To insert in Part II, after clause 22, the following clause:

22A. **Immunisation benefit**—Section 97A (1) of the principal Act (as inserted by section 35 of the Social Security Amendment Act 1972) is hereby amended by omitting the word “administered,—” where it secondly occurs and also paragraphs (a) and (b), and substituting the words “administered, such fees as may be fixed from time to time by the Governor-General by Order in Council. Any such Order in Council may fix different fees in respect of different circumstances under which vaccine is administered and may apply in respect of vaccine administered on or after such date as may be specified in the Order in Council, which may be a date before or after or the same as the date on which the Order in Council is made.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*New clause 22A:* The new clause provides for the immunisation benefit to be fixed by Order in Council instead of being specified in the Act.
