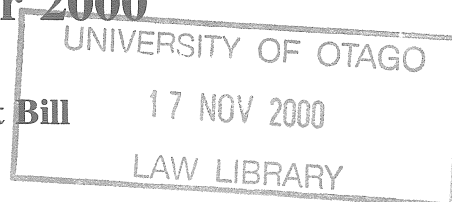

Social Security Amendment Bill



Proposed amendments

Hon Steve Maharey, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 14: new section 54D(4)

To omit from *paragraph (b)* the words “employees organisation (as defined in section 91(2))” (page 10, lines 20 and 21), and substitute the word “union”.

New clause 15A

To insert, after *clause 15* (page 12, after line 35), the following clause:

15A Independent youth benefits: unmarried person

Section 60F(3)(a) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words “employees organisation”, and substituting the word “union”.

Clause 25

To insert, after *subclause (4)* (page 16, after line 38), the following subclause:

(4A) Section 99(4)(b) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words “employees organisation (as defined in section 91(2))”, and substituting the word “union”.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper makes 3 minor amendments to the Social Security Amendment Bill that are necessary for consistency with the Employment Relations Act 2000.
