SUPERANNUATION SCHEMES BILL
Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon. DAVID CAYGILL, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 to 51A* and the Schedules be a separate Bill, with the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to provide for the registration of superannuation schemes, and to provide a procedure to enable benefits payable from superannuation schemes to be reduced as a result of changes in taxation

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Superannuation Schemes Act 1989.
- (2) Section 29 of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1990.
- (3) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 52 to 61* be a separate Bill, with the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to provide a procedure to enable annuities to be reduced as a result of changes in taxation, and to provide for the commutability and assignment of certain annuities

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Annuities (Transitional Provisions) Act 1989.
